Schedules and Boarding Times

Last call for boarding trains and buses may be adjusted throughout the year to up to **5 minutes before** scheduled departure. Check with personnel or Amtrak.com.

Boarding and Arrivals

Walkways to board and deboard trains will vary throughout construction and you may need to walk longer distances. Pay attention to signage, stanchions or ask personnel upon arrival where lines should form.

Stay Informed

- To receive progress updates, email your name and email address to MKEConcourse@dot.wi.gov and reference "Passenger Concourse."
- Before traveling, check on either Amtrak.com, Amtrakhiawatha.com and Greyhound.com to ensure you have the latest updates for your trip.
- Consider using the Milwaukee Airport Station in your travels this year.

Packages and checked baggage may have limits or not be available during some construction phases on Amtrak trips. Check Amtrak.com or speak with Amtrak personnel for updates.
